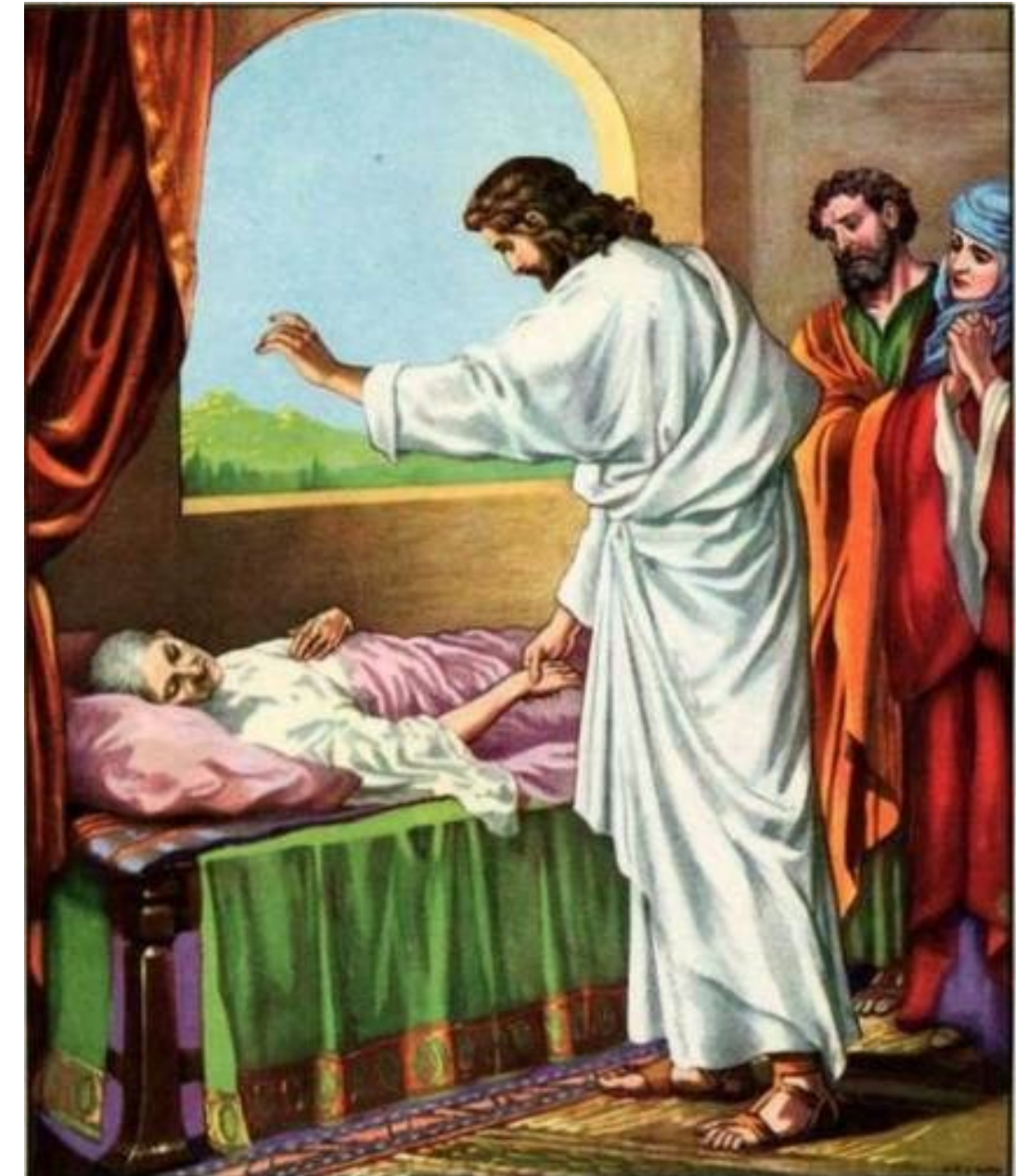

GOSPEL: Mark 1:29-39

On leaving the synagogue Jesus entered the house of Simon and Andrew with James and John. Simon's mother-in-law lay sick with a fever. They immediately told him about her. He approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her and she waited on them.

When it was evening, after sunset, they brought to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. The whole town was gathered at the door. He cured many who were sick with various diseases, and he drove out many demons, not permitting them to speak because they knew him.

Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed. Simon and those who were with him pursued him and on finding him said, "Everyone is looking for you." He told them, "Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come." So he went into their synagogues, preaching and driving out demons throughout the whole of Galilee.

**RCIA Session #21
Sacraments of Healing
Anointing of the Sick**

Presenters: Fr. Carlos

In common with all the sacraments, Anointing of the Sick confers sanctifying grace. The primary purpose of the special grace of this sacrament is to comfort and to strengthen the soul of the sick person. It is the grace that quiets anxiety and dissipates fear. The grace which enables the sick person to embrace God's will and to face the possibility of death without apprehension. It is the grace which gives the soul strength to face and conquer whatever temptations to doubt, despondency, or even despair may mark Satan's last effort to seize this soul for himself. In receiving this sacrament in our last illness, it prepares the soul for entrance into heaven by the forgiveness of venial sins and the cleansing of the soul from the remains of sin.
